- ❖ Mardie Holton-Cleave accepted the role of editor for the North Wind newsletter
- ❖ The successful participation in the 2011 People's Choice CU Community Lottery a major fundraiser for the T-NA. The T-NA to apply for 80 Lottery Books in 2012 lottery.
- ❖ Chairman: Denise McEvoy represented the T-NA at "Greek National Day Laying of the Wreath Ceremony"
- ❖ Mario & Dianne Jaspers represented the T-NA at the George Street Festival (Thebarton) - 11 and 12 December
- ❖ Chairman: Denise McEvoy and Glyn Williams represented the T-NA at the GOCSA 2011 Christmas Dinner
- ❖ It was decided that the T-NA would use Membership Fee Invoices for 2012 as a reminder to members that fees are due. The T-NA has had a good response.
- ❖ Adelaide PC Repairs Mr Jim Stewart & Ms Melissa Jaspers joins the T-NA sponsors list
- ❖ Professional Graphic Artist Sophia Darzanos assigned the task of designing our Early Settler's History Event poster.
- ❖ The T-NA & ECIC held our 170yr Anniversary event entitled "Early Settler's History Displays & Reunion on 10-12 March 2012 at Elliston. The event was a huge

success with over 300 people attending including 150 North Family descendants, raising over \$9000 for the Elliston Community. Many thanks to Kerry Williams & Deb May for their huge efforts toward our event.

- ❖ The new 2012 Elliston Visitor guide mentions George Tramountanas (North) and his arrival in S.A
- ❖ T-NA seeking consultation with West Torrens Council re: recognition of George North (Tramountanas) in Admella Street Thebarton.
- ❖ Maria Hansen was again asked to be the T-NA Financial Auditor for 2011/2012.
- ❖ T-NA Chairman: Denise McEvoy was appointed a People of Australia Ambassador for 2012
- ❖ Now 4 lines of North Family histories completed ie: Mary Ellen North, Clarrie North, Rose North & Cyril North. Many thanks to contributors. These histories will be available to view on the website soon.
- ❖ Mario Jaspers contacted SA Migration Museum (Catherine Manning - Senior Curator) who will accept (when completed) a digital (CD) copy of our Family History Displays for their archives.
- ❖ Steamer “SS Admella” Memorial photos and map – presented to the TNA by Denise McEvoy
- ❖ The Managing Committee resolved to restore the graves of George & Eliza and Hero & Rosina during 2013 after fundraising via the Community Lottery since 2009.
- ❖ John Lesses AM JP providing regular T-NA articles to the Greek Community Tribune Newspaper
- ❖ The T-NA website is being visited regularly and we have had 8500 hits to our Home page by 20th September 2012. The Tramountanas-North Facebook page is growing, currently 265 “friends”. Katherine Mayger (grand-daughter of Michael & Mavis North) has accepted the role of managing the T-NA facebook page.
- ❖ The GOCSA invited the T-NA to include a display during the Odyssey Festival in October 2012. Mario Jaspers met with Maria Foundas in September to finalise the content and space requirements for the display.
- ❖ Membership has grown by 13 in the past 12 months, 8 Full (descendant) members and 5 Associate members.
